

SB 1186 Fee and Reporting Requirements for Local Jurisdictions

Background

Senate Bill 1186 (Chapter 383, 2012) requires a one-dollar additional fee to be paid by any applicant for a local business license, permit or similar instrument when it is issued or renewed. The fee applies to applications and renewals filed between January 1, 2013 and December 31, 2018 and it is collected by the issuing jurisdiction (city, county, or city and county).

The purpose of the fee is to increase disability access and compliance with construction-related accessibility requirements. Additionally, the fee assists local jurisdictions in supporting the [Certified Access Specialist \(CASP\) program](#) and provides the Division of the State Architect (DSA) with funds to maintain oversight of the CASp program. The funds accrued from this fee are then divided between the local entity that collected the funds, which retains 70 percent, and DSA, which receives 30 percent.
